Explanations of the Types of Mental Health Practitioners

Licensed Clinical Social Workers(LCSW) are trained to evaluate a person's mental health and use therapeutic techniques based on specific training

programs. They are also trained in case management and advocacy services.

Licensed Professional Counselors(LPC) are master's-degreed mental health service providers, trained to work with individuals, families, and groups

in treating mental, behavioral, and emotional problems and disorders. They are trained to evaluate a person's mental health and use therapeutic

techniques based on specific training programs.

Licensed Marriage and Family Therapists(LMFT), like LPCs, are master's-degreed mental health service providers, trained to work with individuals,

families, and groups in treating mental, behavioral, and emotional problems and disorders. Their degree is in the area of marriage or family therapy.

Pastoral Counselors are trained provide support and guidance to people of all ages and circumstances who are looking to approach their issues from

a spiritual perspective. They help address personal conflict, marriage and family, or spiritual issues.

Psychologists(PSY.D.) hold a doctoral degree in clinical psychology, counseling, or education. They are trained to evaluate a person's mental health

using clinical interviews, psychological evaluations and testing and can make diagnoses and provide individual and group therapy.

Psychiatrists(MD) are licensed medical doctors who have completed psychiatric training. They can diagnose mental health conditions, prescribe and monitor medications and provide therapy.
