

Sermon Guide: Week 2 – What Will You Burn For?

Key Text: Leviticus 6:13 – “The fire must be kept burning on the altar continuously; it must not go out.”

Message Summary

This week’s message challenges us to examine what we’re burning for. God’s fire isn’t one of destruction—it’s a fire of devotion that refines and draws us closer to Him. Leviticus 6 reminds us to keep the fire on the altar burning continuously. To live this way, we must surrender daily, remove distractions, and fuel our passion through prayer, worship, and fasting.

Are you ready to let God ignite a fresh fire in your life?

Key Points

- 1. Burn Continuously**
 - Fire doesn’t sustain itself—it takes daily effort. Romans 12:1 calls us to be living sacrifices, fully surrendered to God every day. What steps can you take to keep your fire burning?
 - 2. Burn Rightly**
 - Ashes from bitterness, pride, or distractions can smother the fire of God. Clearing these out allows His presence to shine brighter. What needs to go in your life?
 - 3. Burn Brightly**
 - Fire needs fuel. Spend time in prayer, worship, and fasting to create space for God to breathe new life into you.

 - What’s one way you can create space for God to move during these 21 days of prayer and fasting?

 3. What distractions or “ashes” could you remove to make more space for God?
 4. How can this group support you during these 21 days of prayer and fasting?
